

TAIWAN'S HORIZON BUILDING FD102 FOR 2020

TAIWANESE YARD HORIZON has sold its first FD102 Skyline to a European owner. The contract was signed at the Monaco Yacht Show in late September and delivery is scheduled for 2020.

The superyacht is part of the Fast Displacement range that includes the new FD77 Skyline for owner-operators, FD85, FD87 Skyline (*Spotlight*, May/June 2018) and FD125 Skyline.

Featuring an overall length of 105ft and a 24ft 2in beam, the FD102 Skyline was created in collaboration with Dutch designer Cor D. Rover and has a striking profile, high-performance hull design, large outdoor spaces and impressive interior volume.

Inside, the yacht has double saloons, an on-deck master stateroom and a spacious four-stateroom-layout on the lower deck.

On the upper deck, a walk-around deck maintains the privacy of the interior spaces and links the forward outdoor areas, which include a Jacuzzi forward of the bridge, an aft-facing C-shaped settee and a large sunpad. A lounging/dining area and space for tender stowage is located aft. A spacious beach club and large aft deck area are found on her lower levels.

CEO John Lu said: "The FD102 Skyline shows Horizon possesses strong design and construction abilities that allow us to turn an owner's dream into reality. Since the series was introduced with the first FD85 in November 2016, the feedback from owners and potential clients has served to streamline the FD102 design and create a truly remarkable ocean-going superyacht that offers performance, stability, and spacious interior and exterior areas."

Hull one of the FD77 is currently in production for the American market and is expected to debut in early 2019 at the Miami and Palm Beach shows, while hulls two and three are intended for the European and Australian markets respectively.
